RYAN MILLEN AND COLIN GODBY TACKLE THE 2008 TRANSSYBERIAN RALLY

TUSTIN, Calif. – MillenWorks employees Ryan Millen and Colin Godby form the Porsche Team USA entry preparing to tackle the 2008 Transsyberia Rally in a specially prepared “evo” version of the Porsche Cayenne S Transsyberia. Ryan continues the Millen family’s racing legacy and is attempting to repeat his father’s victory at the same rally in 2007. The 4,347-mile route will traverse the Ural Mountains, wind through the pristine sub-arctic forests of Siberia, up to the rugged peaks of the Altai Mountains and continue across the sprawling, barren Mongolian plains and on through the legendary Gobi Desert, prior to reaching the finish line in Ulaanbaatar, the capital of Mongolia. The 2008 Transsyberia rally is set to begin in Moscow’s Red Square on July 11th and finish in Ulaanbaatar, the capitol of Mongolia on July 25.



Over the past six years, Ryan Millen has competed in the arduous Baja 1000 desert race, completing every race and scoring podium finishes in his class for the last two years. Ryan also scored a class victory at the 2007 Taupo 1000 in New Zealand, billed as the longest off-road race in the southern hemisphere. Ryan’s desert racing and endurance racing experience is predated by open wheel experience in the Skip-Barber Dodge Pro Series and championship success in Formula Ford New Zealand series.

Co-driving for Ryan will be Colin Godby, a MillenWorks mechanical engineer as well as a longtime friend to Ryan. "Colin and I are a good match," Ryan says, "We're both outdoorsy and we're used to dealing with adversity and difficulty in the wilderness. We drove together in the Baja 1000 and he's an intelligent guy." Colin’s engineering expertise, Ryan’s driving skill and their desert racing experience stands them in good stead heading into the 2008 Transsyberia rally. A rally that last year’s winner and MillenWorks CEO Rod Millen termed the toughest event he has ever tackled.
